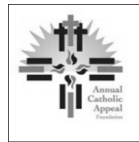
ADULT CONFIRMATION

Preparation for Adult Confirmation will begin on **WEDNESDAY**, August 19 from 6:30 pm to 8:45 pm in the Merrifield Room of the Parish Office. Classes are for those **19** years or older who are **baptized Catholic** and have **made their First Communion** - but have not been Confirmed. Classes continue on Wednesdays until October 14 and attendance of all classes is required unless excused. Confirmation will be Thursday, October 8 at 6:00 pm. **If you are married, you must be married in the Catholic Church by a Priest or Deacon and be able to provide verification of this marriage.** Please contact Deacon Jack Granato at 271-0551 or 459-9010 for more information and to register.

YOUTH CONFIRMATION

Due to Covid 19, the Parish Office is not open for Registration for Youth Confirmation. A REGISTRATION opportunity is scheduled for Sunday, August 30 from 1:00 to 3:00 pm. Parents wishing to register their youth for Confirmation preparation this year **MUST** attend this session. Registration will be held in the CHURCH so that we can social-distance. Parents **MUST** bring a COPY of the youth's Baptismal Certificate AND be prepared to pay the Registration fee of \$30 per FAMILY at that time. A make-up date for Registration will be on Saturday, September 5 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon also in the Church. Depending on the number of youth registering, there may have to be 2 classes. Face masks are required to be worn for the Registration.
