A Letter from our Pastor

Dear OLA Parish Family,

On Friday, November 13, 2020, the Governor issued modified health orders allowing houses of worship to accommodate the lesser of 25% capacity or 75 persons. Archbishop Wester has decided to ease his restrictions because of the disappointment many of the faithful have expressed to him; consequently, effective tomorrow we will resume our normal Mass schedule with a capacity of 75 individuals:

Sunday Masses: 7:30 am, 9:00 am (Bilingual) and 10:30 am (Nov 22nd)

Sunday Mass Obligation: 5:00 pm Saturday (Nov 21st)

Weekday Mass: Tuesday - Friday 9:00 am (Beginning Nov 17th)

Confessions: Saturday 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm (Nov 21st)

The Archbishop continues to **strongly** recommend that the elderly and those with underlying health conditions remain home and away from gatherings, as the danger of COVID infection not only continues but has worsened dramatically in recent weeks. **Remember, if you do not attend Mass the dispensation is still in effect.**

Our Parish will continue to follow the safety practices below:

Those who believe they may have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 should not attend Mass. One should not attend Mass if he or she is experiencing any symptoms of illness, especially the following:

- A temperature above 100.4 F
- Cough or sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- The recent loss of smell or taste
- Chills, muscle aches, or gastrointestinal upset

The Archdiocese has strictly advised that all parishioners must adhere to the following rules:

- *Wear a mask while attending Mass*
- *Maintain six feet of social distance from others, not from the same household*
- *Refrain from physical contact such as holding hands*
- *Singing will be held to a minimum*

Please be extra cautious if attending Mass. I look forward to seeing you.




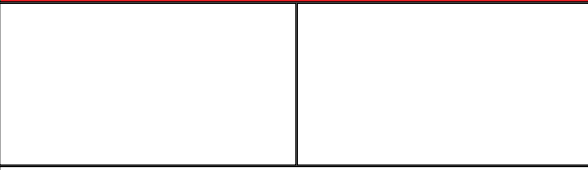

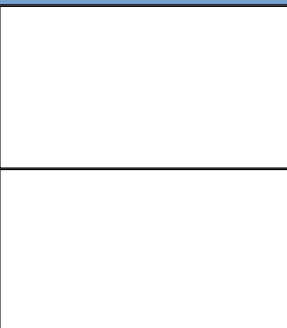
