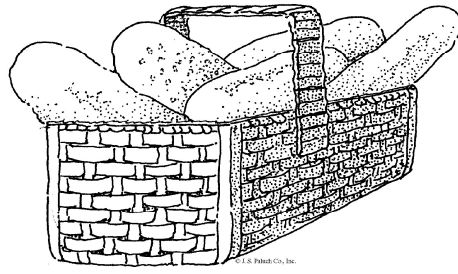

Preparation for **Adult Confirmation** will begin Wednesday September 1, from 6:30 pm to 8:45 in the Merrifield Room of the Parish Office. Classes are for those **19** years of older who are **Baptized Catholic** and have made their **First Communion**, but have Not been Confirmed. Classes continue on Wednesday’s until October 20th, with a retreat on October 9th. Attendance of all classes and the Retreat is required unless excused.
