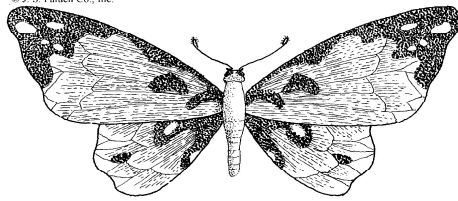

**LOST AND FOUND**

The parable of the father and his sons is one of the most familiar of all of Jesus' stories. The Israelites spent many years lost in the desert, seeking the land of milk and honey, yet often failing to seek the God who delivered and fed them. We are sometimes lost as well.
