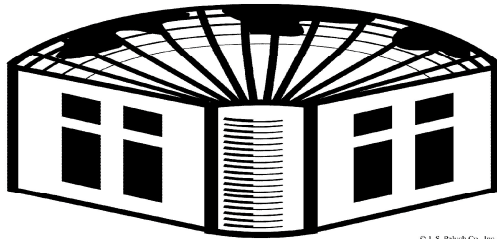
Mission Statement:

A FORETASTE OF PARADISE

Throughout Easter Time, the Church rejoices
 with Jesus, risen from the dead. Our readings on
 this Fourth Sunday of Easter celebrate our instinct
 to come together in joy, worshiping in church.
 While private prayer nourishes our individual rela-
 tionship with the Lord, community prayer is a
 foretaste of paradise. The book of Revelation de-
 picts a "great multitude" worshipping God "day and
 night in his temple." Our churches on Easter Sun-
 day often reflect this happy multitude, filling the
 pews to bursting. Four Sundays into the festive
 season, we are encouraged to keep praising God
 together. In the Acts of the Apostles, Paul and Bar-
 nabas demonstrate their instinct to worship with
 their faith community each Sabbath, dutifully tak-
 ing their seats in the synagogue. In the Gospel,
 Jesus calls us his sheep and reminds us why com-
 ing together as a flock is so important: uniting in
 community, we imitate the unity of God.

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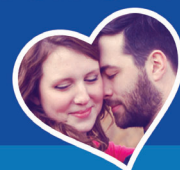
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
