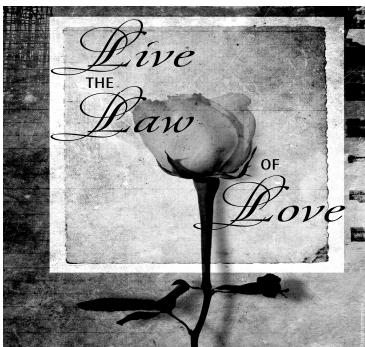

**RIGHT RELATIONSHIPS**

Our God is about relationships. In the first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites that the laws, which are already in their hearts, keep them in right relationship with the God who loves them so much that they always find forgiveness. Centuries later, along comes Jesus, whom Paul describes to the Colossians as “the image of the invisible God,” the very embodiment of this God of love. In his parable about the good Samaritan, Jesus explains how the law of love overrules the letter of the law. Instead of answering the question “Who is my neighbor?” Jesus demonstrates that it is not about who is worthy of being loved, but rather loving as God loves—about *being* neighbor, about being the good Samaritan. Jesus wants us to continue his work as images of this God of love by loving *all* people, even those who seem to be our enemies.

**YOUTH CONFIRMATION**

Registration for Youth Confirmation can be done in the Parish Office. Parents **MUST** bring a **COPY** of the youth’s Baptismal Certificate **AND** be prepared to pay the registration fee at that time. Cost is \$30.00 per family. Youth Confirmation is for those who are in **9th—12th grades**. There will be an Orientation for **ONE** parent or guardian. **AND** the youth on Sunday **September 11 at 11:45am** in the Merrifield Room of the Parish Office. **Please register BEFORE the Orientation!**

**ADULT CONFIRMATION**

Preparation for Adult Confirmation will begin **Wednesday, September 7, 2022** from 6:30pm to 8:45pm in the Merrifield Room in the parish office. Classes are for those **19** years or older who are **baptized Catholic and have made their First Communion**, but have not been Confirmed. Classes meet on Wednesdays until November 2nd, with a retreat on October 22. Attendance of all classes and the Retreat is required unless excused. Confirmation will be Friday October 28, at 6:00pm. **If you are married, you must be married in the Catholic Church by a Priest or a Deacon and provide verification of this marriage.**
