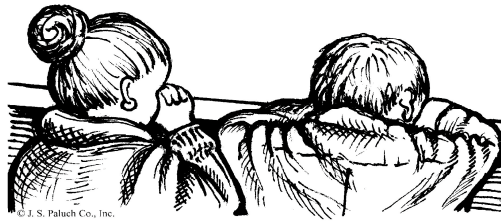

THE GIFT OF FAITH

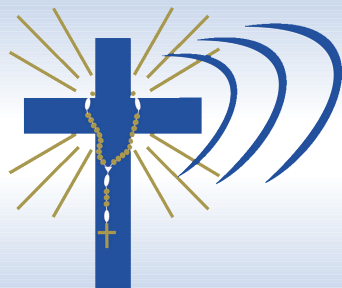

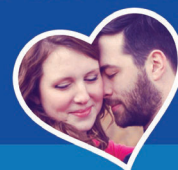
