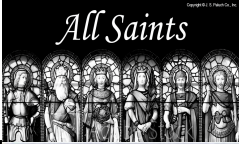

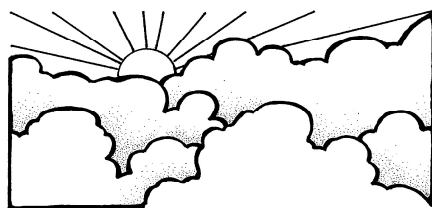
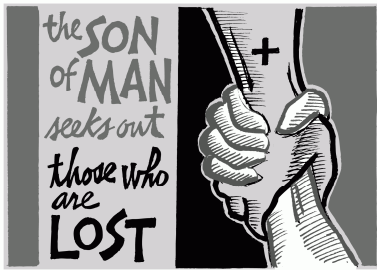

PRAYER OF THE WEEK

Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Almighty and merciful God, by whose gift your faithful offer you right and praiseworthy service, grant, we pray, that we may hasten without stumbling to receive the things you have promised.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen

A COMPASSIONATE GOD

Today's reading from the book of Wisdom presents an image of a patient God who "rebuke[s] offenders little by little" (Wisdom 12:2), an image endorsed by the psalmist, singing of how the LORD is "slow to anger and of great kindness, and compassionate toward all his works" (Psalm 145:8, 9). The crowd with Jesus, however, grumbles when they see Jesus's kindness and compassion extended to Zacchaeus, who was not just a tax collector, but the "chief tax collector"—a title that surely emphasizes his standing as a sinner to be scorned. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the Thessalonians to be "worthy" of God's calling, so that "the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you" (2 Thessalonians 1:12); such people, unlike the crowd in the Gospel, would rejoice at Zacchaeus's determination to change his life after encountering Jesus.

On **Saturday November 12th** from **1:00 - 3:00 pm** at the parish office, SVDP will register 70 families for the **Christmas Gift Giving Program** for families living within our parish boundaries, OLA registered families and those who have children in our school or religious education program. Children must be 12 years of age or younger and a birth certificate is required for each child. Please bring clothing size information for each child so as to receive a gift of the right size.

On **Saturday November 19th** from **1:00 - 3:00 pm** SVDP will provide **Thanksgiving meal food boxes** to 70 families for the annual Thanksgiving food distribution. These boxes will be given out on a first come first serve basis with only **one box per address**.

TO QUALIFY, A FAMILY MUST:

- Live within the parish boundaries
- Show valid proof of residency (utility bill or lease with your name on it)
- Picture ID matching the proof of residency address

This will be the only day to receive a Thanksgiving box. Arrive at the allotted time, stay in your vehicle, and form a line starting in the church parking lot.

The parish boundaries are San Pedro NE to Eubank NE and Central NE to Indian School NE.
