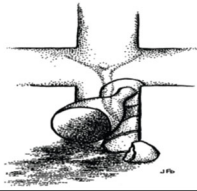

Today's Readings - June 11, 2023 • Year A
Body & Blood of Christ

Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16a • God's care
 Corinthians 10:16-17 • Our blessing cup
 John 6:51-58 • The living bread

On the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, the church gives us three readings reminding us how God feeds us. In the first reading from Deuteronomy, Moses reminds the people how God fed them with manna and gave them water from a rock during their arduous journey in the wilderness when they thought they might die of hunger and thirst. In the letter to the Corinthians, Paul reminds us that when we share the Eucharist, we are participating in the Body of Christ. Finally, the Gospel reading centers on Jesus' teaching to the Jewish crowds about being the bread of life.

En la fiesta del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, la iglesia nos regala tres lecturas que nos recuerdan cómo nos alimenta Dios. En la primera lectura del Deuteronomio, Moisés le recuerda al pueblo cómo Dios los alimentó con maná y les dio agua de una roca durante su arduo viaje por el desierto cuando pensaban que podrían morir de hambre y sed. En la carta a los Corintios, Pablo nos recuerda que cuando compartimos la Eucaristía, estamos participando del Cuerpo de Cristo. Finalmente, la lectura del Evangelio se centra en la enseñanza de Jesús a las multitudes judías acerca de ser el pan de vida.

The idea that Jesus was the Messiah, sent by God, was too difficult for many to grasp. Later Jesus even challenged his own disciples with the question: "And you, would you also like to leave?"
