SEXUAL ABUSE PREVENTION

The Archdiocese of Santa Fe has instituted a policy requiring all employees, parishioners, school parents and siblings, 18 years of age or older who are involved in a parish or school ministry, to take the Abuse Awareness class every five (5) years. If it has been five years or greater since you have taken this class, you are required to attend a class offered at the Catholic Center or complete the online course.

Create your user ID and password and continue to first complete your background check and then complete the class. If you begin the class but cannot finish it, you can log off and sign in at a later date, the class will continue where you left off.
