Today's Readings - June 25, 2023 • Year A

Jeremiah 20:10–13 • Jeremiah's faith in crisis
Romans 5:12–15 • Mankind's sin through Adam
Matthew 10:26–33 • Reassurance to the Twelve

In this Gospel reading, Jesus is speaking to the apostles immediately after giving them a terrifying task. Just when all the apostles may have been reconsidering their mission, Jesus addressed their fears. He told them boldly that they shouldn't fear anyone. He urged them to speak with confidence and strength. He reminded them that they are worth far more than two song birds who are known, watched over, and cared for by God. He put their physical worries and fears into perspective.
