Today's Readings

Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9 • Renewal of the tablets
 2 Corinthians 13:11-13 • Farewell
 John 3:16-18 • Belief in the Son sent by the Father

On this feast of the Most Holy Trinity, otherwise known as Trinity Sunday, each reading points to different aspects of God's identity. The first reading recounts the glimpse of the creator God whom Moses encountered on Mount Sinai: a "merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Paul's Letter to the Corinthians reminds us of the gifts that each person of the Trinity has to offer us: "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit." In the Gospel reading, John tells us of a God who loves us so much that he allowed his Son to leave his side and come into our world to experience human life.

En esta fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, también es conocido como Domingo de la Trinidad, cada lectura apunta a diferentes aspectos de la identidad de Dios. La primera lectura relata la visión del Dios creador a quien Moisés encontró en el Monte Sinai: un "Dios compasivo y clemente, lento para la ira y abundante en misericordia y verdad."

La Carta de Pablo a los Corintios nos recuerda de los dones que cada persona de la Trinidad tiene para ofrecernos: "la gracia del Señor Jesucristo y el amor de Dios y la comunión del Espíritu Santo." En la lectura del Evangelio, Juan nos habla de un Dios que nos ama tanto que permitió que su Hijo se apartara de su lado y viene a nuestro mundo para experimentar la vida humana.

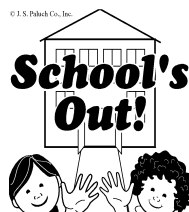
