Today's Readings

Acts 8:5-8, 14-17 • Philip in Samaria
1 Peter 3:15-18 • On Christian suffering
John 14:15-21 • Promise of the Paraclete

This Gospel reading picks up just a few verses after last week's Gospel left off. Jesus is still speaking to the disciples on the night before he dies. The disciples are still worried and concerned by Jesus' predictions of betrayal and denial. Jesus continues to reassure them, now introducing the promise of the Holy Spirit, sometimes called the "Advocate" or the Paraclete."

Esta lectura del Evangelio comienza solo unos pocos versos después el Evangelio de la semana pasada. Jesús todavía está hablando a los discípulos en la noche antes de morir. Los discípulos todavía están preocupados por las predicciones de Jesús de traición y negación. Jesús continúa tranquilizándolos, ahora introduce la promesa del Santo Espíritu, a veces llamado el "Abogado" o el "Paráclito".

Jesus' words to the disciples at the last supper gave the assurance that the Spirit would come and be with them always. Jesus said that we would see what the world does not see. In the Liturgy of the Eucharist Jesus' promise is fulfilled. It is in the breaking of the bread that we remember what he said: "You will see me" because "on that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you."
