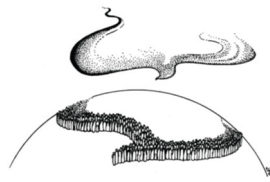

Today’s Readings

Acts 1:1–11 • The Ascension of Jesus
Ephesians 1:17-23 • A Spirit of wisdom
Matthew 28:16-20 • Commissioning of the disciples

Even after experiencing Jesus after his resurrection, the apostles remain fully human, still capable of believing in him and having their doubts at the same time. Fortunately, Jesus isn’t into shaming; he doesn’t scold them for doubting. The final verse of this Gospel offers a promise that can still console today: “Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” Although we may not be able to physically see Jesus, he wanted future believers to know that his presence continues.

Incluso después de experimentar a Jesús después de su resurrección, los apóstoles siguen siendo plenamente humanos, todavía capaces de creer en Jesús y teniendo sus dudas al mismo tiempo. Afortunadamente, a Jesús no le gusta avergonzar; Él no lo regaña por dudar. El verso final de este Evangelio ofrece una promesa que hoy puede consolar: “...yo estaré con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin del mundo”. Aunque no podemos ver a Jesús físicamente, él quiere que los futuros creyentes sepan que su presencia continúa en nosotros.

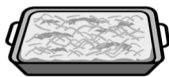

THE GOOD SHEPHERD MINISTRY

The Good Shepherd Center, downtown provides many services to homeless men in the community. Their Services include:

- Housing Reestablishment Program
- Housing Voucher Program
- Fresh Start Substance Abuse recovery
- Overnight and temporary shelter for men
- Respite beds
- Daily Meals
- Men's Clothing
- Mail service

Daily meals are provided Monday - Saturday and are open to everyone. The Good Shepherd averages 275 hot meals served per day and is supported by The Casserole Ministry Program in ours and other Parishes.



Casserole cooking is a simple way to give of your time and talent, and it provides good, hot meals to our community's homeless and hungry men, women, and children. Come to the Parish Office during regular business hours to pick up recipes and containers. For more information, contact the Parish Office.

In 2023, OLA has provided 103 casseroles as of this printing.
