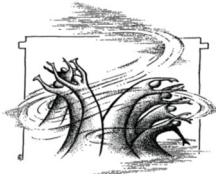

1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13 • One body in Christ
John 20:19-23 • “Receive the Holy Spirit”

In the Gospel reading today, Jesus breathed on the apostles just as God breathed life into the first human. Like the readings from John’s Gospel that we’ve heard the last few weeks, Jesus is showing his friends that he is one and the same as God. Just as the first human came alive with God’s breath, so the apostles come alive in a new way when they receive the Holy Spirit.

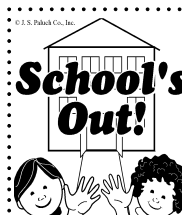
