Today’s Readings

Acts 6:1-7 • The need of assistants
1 Peter 2:4-9 • Living stones
John 14:1-12 • Last discourse: the way, the truth, and the life

Today’s Gospel passage can be boiled down to two main points, but they may be hard to grasp because Jesus seems to speak in circles. First, don’t let your hearts be troubled. Second, if you know Jesus, you know God. If you didn’t get those upon first reading, take heart; neither did the apostle Philip.
