2023 Adult Confirmation Classes Beginning!

Preparation for Adult Confirmation will begin on **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 23, 2023** from 6:30 pm to 8:45 pm in the Merrifield Room of the Parish Office.

Classes are for those **19** years or older who are **Baptized Catholic AND** have made their **First Communion, but have not been Confirmed.**

Classes meet on Wednesdays until October 25, with a retreat on October 21. Attendance of all classes and the Retreat is required unless excuse. Confirmation will be Friday October 27, 2023 at 7:00 pm. **If you are married, you must be married in the Catholic Church by a Priest or a Deacon and provide verification of this marriage.
