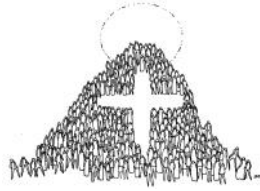

Today's Readings - August 6, 2023

Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14 • Daniel's Vision of the Kingdom of God
2 Peter 1:16-19 • Apostolic Witness
Matthew 17:1-9 • Transfiguration of Jesus

When Jesus took Peter, James, and John with him up the mountain where he was transfigured so that his clothes became dazzling white, they very well may have thought of Daniel's vision. As Jews themselves, they would have heard that story read aloud in their synagogues, and they had probably puzzled over what it might meant. By the time Peter wrote the passage in our second reading, he is clear that Jesus was the one symbolized in Daniel's vision, and that God on the throne shares the power and glory with Jesus. "So we have the prophetic message more fully confirmed," Peter wrote about the incident on the mountain top.

2 Pedro 1:16-19 • Testimonio Apostólico
Mateo 17:1-9 • Transfiguración de Jesús

Cuando Jesús llevó a Pedro, Santiago y Juan con él a la montaña donde fue transfigurado para que su ropa se volviera blanca deslumbrante, es muy posible que hayan pensado en la visión de Daniel. Ellos como judíos, habrían escuchado esa historia leída en voz alta en sus sinagogas, y probablemente se habían desconcertado sobre lo que podría significar. Para cuando Pedro escribió el pasaje en nuestra segunda lectura, tiene claro que Jesús era el simbolizado en la visión de Daniel, y que Dios en el trono comparte el poder y la gloria con Jesús. "Así que tenemos el mensaje profético más plenamente confirmado", escribió Pedro sobre el incidente en la cima de la montaña.

Thought for the Week

The Transfiguration takes place right after Jesus reveals to his disciples that he is not going to save the world in the way they expect, but by dying on the cross—and that anyone who accepts him as Savior must “carry the cross,” which means to accept those particular consequences of the sin of the world which happen to fall on us and to respond with love. The power Jesus uses to save the world is the power he gives us to love back, no matter what happens to us.

Pensamiento de la Semana

La Transfiguración tiene lugar justo después de Jesús. revela a sus discípulos que no va a salvar el mundo de la manera que ellos esperan, pero por muriendo en la cruz—y que cualquiera que lo acepte como Salvador debe “llevar la cruz”, lo que significa aceptar aquellas consecuencias particulares del pecado del mundo que cae sobre nosotros y responde con amar. El poder que Jesús usa para salvar al mundo es el
