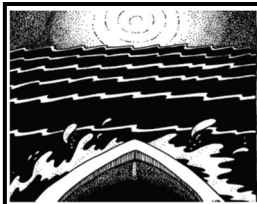

Thought for the Week

Often people hear this passage of Peter's failed attempt to walk on water, and they hear criticism in Jesus' voice: "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" They assume Jesus was disappointed that Peter doubted him. But Jesus wasn't sinking. Peter was. So what if it's the other way around? What if Jesus was asking Peter why he doubted *himself* and his own ability to walk on water?

Pensamiento de la Semana

A menudo la gente oye este pasaje del intento fallido de Pedro de caminar sobre el agua, y escuchan críticas en la voz de Jesús: "Hombre de poca fe, ¿por qué dudaste?" (NBLA) Asumen que Jesús estaba decepcionado de que Pedro dudara de él. Pero Jesús no se estaba hundiendo. Pedro lo estaba. Entonces, ¿qué pasa si es al revés? ¿Qué pasaría si Jesús le preguntara a Pedro por qué dudaba de sí mismo y de su propia capacidad para caminar sobre el agua?
