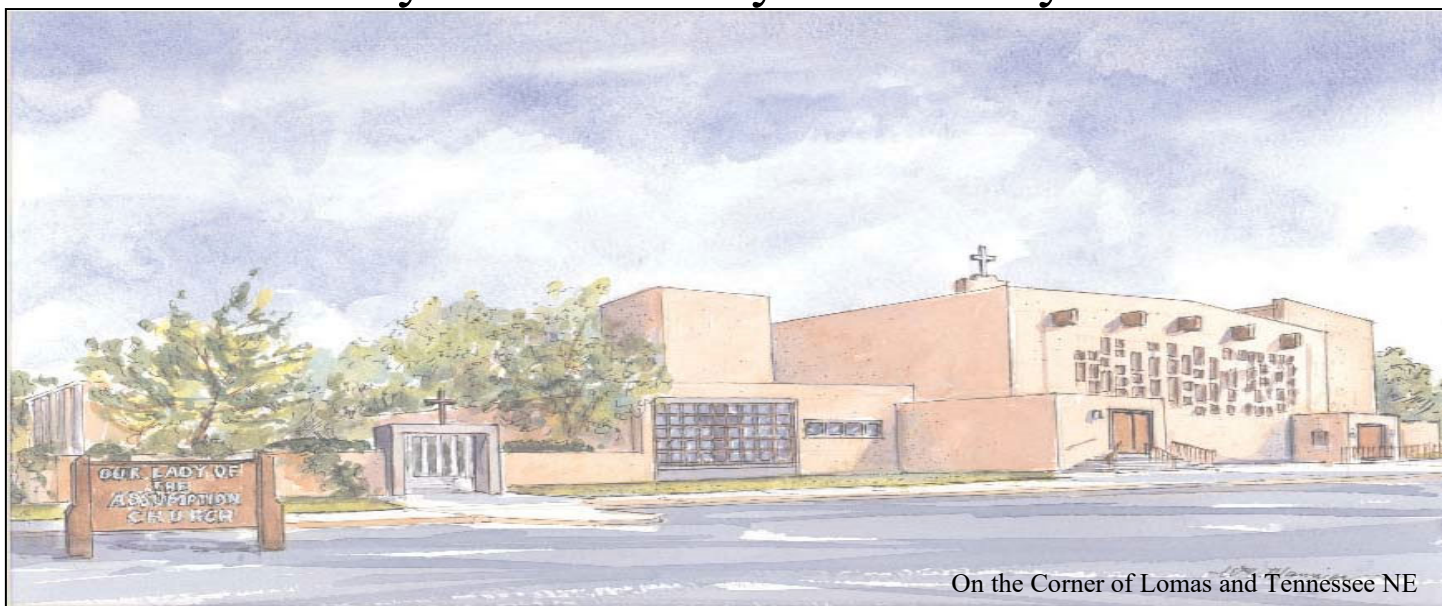

Today's Readings - September 17, 2023

Sirach 27:30-28:7 • Call to forgiveness and mercy
Romans 14:7-9 • To live and die for Christ
Matthew 18:21-35 • The merciless official

The Gospel parable invites us to search for the people in our lives whom we have not forgiven. Most of us have been deeply hurt in the past. Some of us have been able to forgive. Others may still be carrying bitterness. We cannot track the clean floors of heaven with the muddy boots of our resentments. We must first clean away all anger by forgiving everyone who has offended us. It is a stern lesson indeed. It's a lesson we need to remember each time we pray the Lord's Prayer: "...forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."
