Today's Readings - October 1, 2023

Ezekiel 18:25-28 • Personal responsibility
Philippians 2:1-11 • Imitating the humility of Christ
Matthew 21:28-32 • Parable of the two sons

The parable provides a little mirror through which we can see our true selves. On Sunday we may be like the first son who says, “Yes Lord, I am going to follow you and serve you.” But then comes Monday and we may fail to do it. At other times we may be the rebellious second son, refusing to do what we know God is calling us to do. When we do decide to obey the commandments which the Father has given us...when we do decide to follow Jesus...when with the help of the Holy Spirit we faithfully live up to those commitments, then will our actions have met the parable's test of obedience.
