Se debe proporcionar un certificado de nacimiento válido o una identificación escolar vigente para cada niño.

Si más de una familia vive en la misma dirección, cada familia debe proporcionar el comprobante de residencia requerido y una identificación con fotografía con la dirección correspondiente. Este será el único día para solicitar este programa, por favor no llame a la oficina parroquial.

CHRISTMAS GIFT GIVING PROGRAM**

On Saturday, November 18th from 1:00-3:00 pm, the St. Vincent de Paul Society will register up to 50 families for the annual children's gifts. All applicants must register in person at the parish office. To qualify you must meet the following requirements;

- Live within the boundaries of San Pedro to Eubank NE, and Central NE to Indian School, or have children in our school or CCD program.
- Valid proof of residency (utility bill, lease or mortgage agreement with your name on it)
- Picture ID matching the proof of residency address
- The child must be 12 years old or younger
- Valid birth certificate or current school ID must be provided for each child

If more than one family lives at the same address, each family must provide the required proof of residency and picture ID with the matching address. **This will be the only day to apply for this program, please do not call the parish office.**
