Today's Readings - January 28, 2024

First Reading:

Moses taught the Israelites that God would raise up a prophet like him to teach them the Lord's commands. But he also forewarned about false prophets. How can we avoid listening to false prophetic voices?

Second Reading:

Paul expresses his desire for the Corinthian believers to be free of anxiety so they can focus their attention and energies on Jesus. What distracts you from the Lord?

Gospel:

Mark informs us that early in Jesus's public ministry his "fame spread" quickly throughout Galilee because of his powerful deeds, such as the healing of the demon-possessed man in today's reading. Is there something or someone in your life that you pray Jesus would heal? ©LPi

The Good Shepherd Center, downtown provides many services to homeless men in the community. Their Services include:

- Housing Reestablishment Program
- Housing Voucher Program
- Fresh Start Substance Abuse recovery
- Overnight and temporary shelter for men
- Respite beds
- Daily Meals
- Men's Clothing
- Mail service

Daily meals are provided Monday - Saturday and are open to everyone. The Good Shepherd averages 275 hot meals served per day and is supported by The Casserole Ministry Program in ours and other Parishes.
