The Good Shepherd Center, downtown provides many services to homeless men in the community. Their Services include:

- Housing Reestablishment Program
- Housing Voucher Program
- Fresh Start Substance Abuse recovery
- Overnight and temporary shelter for men
- Respite beds
- Daily Meals
- Men’s Clothing
- Mail service

Daily meals are provided Monday - Saturday and are open to everyone. The Good Shepherd averages 275 hot meals served per day and is supported by The Casserole Ministry Program in ours and other Parishes.

Casserole cooking is a simple way to give of your time and talent, and it provides good, hot meals to our community’s homeless and hungry men, women, and children.
