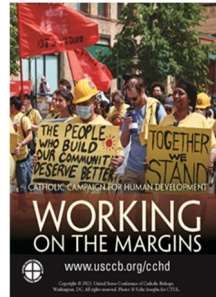


THANKSGIVING DAY MASS
