SAINT OF THE WEEK **St. Faustina**

Biography

St. Faustina (1905-1938) was born Helena Kowalska in Poland to a poor family with ten children. They were devoutly Catholic, and she felt a call to the religious life at age seven, when praying in front of the exposed Eucharist. Despite wanting to become a sister as soon as she finished her schooling, she was sent to work as a housekeeper to help support the family instead.

When she was 18, she had a vision of Jesus suffering and, in the vision, Jesus asked her how long she would keep putting off entering religious life. She decided, at that moment, to travel to Warsaw and join the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Upon entering the Congregation, she took the name Sister Maria Faustina.

During her 13 years in the Congregation, Sister Faustina experienced and recorded extraordinary revelations from Jesus. She recorded these experiences and messages into notebooks which became later known as the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*. In these writings, she reveals Jesus asking her to proclaim God's loving message of Divine Mercy.

Alongside her writings, Sister Faustina also experienced

many miraculous phenomena. There are stories of her experiencing hidden stigmata, bilocation, prophecy, and the ability to read into human souls. Despite these occurrences, she maintained that miraculous events were simply "ornaments" for the soul and that her real sanctity came from her deep relationship with Jesus and desire to do God's will.

After her death at age 33, her writings on Divine Mercy sparked a great movement in the worldwide Catholic church with a strong focus on the Mercy of Christ and how to extend that mercy to others. Saint Pope John Paul II called her "the great apostle of Divine Mercy in our time." St. Faustina, pray for us!

St. Faustina

Biografia

Santa Faustina (1905-1938) nació como Helena Kowalska en Polonia en una familia pobre con diez hijos. Eran devotamente católicos, y ella sintió un llamado a la vida religiosa a los siete años, al orar frente a la Eucaristía expuesta. A pesar de querer convertirse en hermana tan pronto como terminara sus estudios, la enviaron a trabajar como ama de llaves para ayudar a mantener a la familia.

Cuando tenía 18 años, tuvo una visión de Jesús sufriendo y, en la visión, Jesús le preguntó cuánto tiempo seguiría posergiendo el ingreso a la vida religiosa. Decidió, en ese momento, viajar a Varsovia e ingresar en la Congregación de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Merced. Al ingresar a la Congregación tomó el nombre de Sor María Faustina.

Durante sus 13 años en la Congregación, Sor Faustina experimentó y registró extraordinarias revelaciones de Jesús. Registró estas experiencias y mensajes en cuadernos que más tarde se conocieron como el Diario de Santa María Faustina Kowalska. En estos escritos, ella revela a Jesús pidiéndole que proclame el amoroso mensaje de Dios de la Divina Misericordia.

Paralelamente a sus escritos, Sor Faustina también experimentó muchos fenómenos milagrosos. Hay historias de ella experimentando estigmas ocultos, bilocación, profecía y la capacidad de leer en las almas humanas. A pesar de estos sucesos, ella sostuvo que los acontecimientos milagrosos eran simplemente "adornos" para el alma y que su verdadera santidad provenía de su profunda relación con Jesús y del deseo de hacer la voluntad de Dios.

Después de su muerte a los 33 años, sus escritos sobre la Divina Misericordia provocaron un gran movimiento en la iglesia católica mundial con un fuerte enfoque en la Misericordia de Cristo y cómo extender esa misericordia a los demás. El Papa San Juan Pablo II la llamó "la gran apóstol de la Divina Misericordia en nuestro tiempo." Santa Faustina, ¡ruega por nosotros! © LPI
